Did he just say, the Nazi Neoliberals?

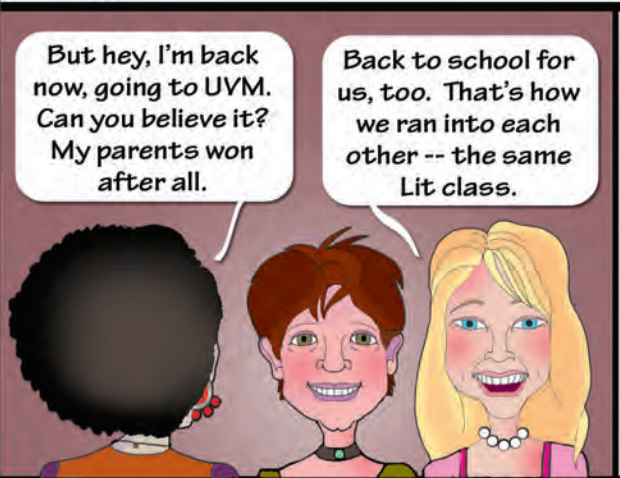


Do you remember me? Senior Choir?

She's got two -- they're adorable!

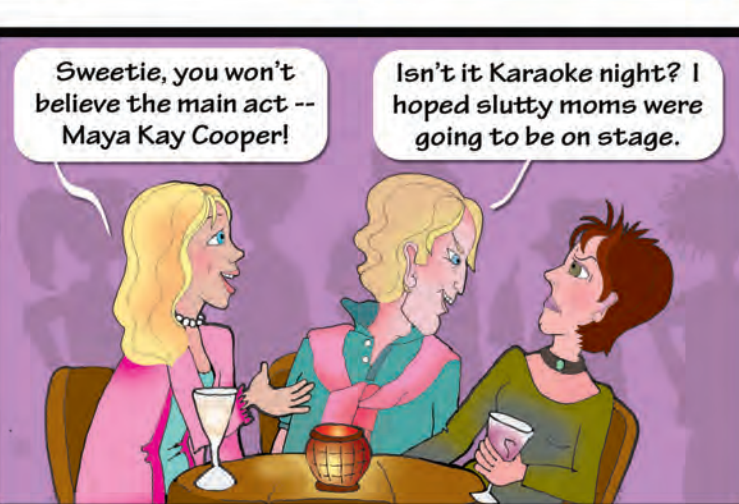


Oh look, it's Blaise. He's early. Blaise! Over here!
